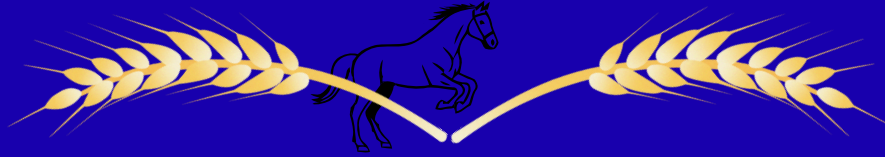


Show Horse Program



Welcome to the Horse Section!

We are delighted to welcome you to the Horse Section of the 2026 Kellerberrin Agricultural Show. Whether you are a competitor, a spectator, or simply an admirer of these magnificent animals, we hope you have an enjoyable experience. Below you will find the schedule for all events and important information for participants.

Event Schedule

0830 Commence In-hand events

1030 Commence ridden hacking.

1230 Lead-line section will be ridden as a whole, starting with the hacking, moving to the games and then the poles for Showjumping.

1330 Commence jumping.

Important Information for Competitors

Entry Fees:

- Pre-entry: TBC
- On-the-day entry: incur a \$15 late fee.

Class information:

- Entry forms are to follow, all classes will be subject to change depending on entries.
- Prizes and money will be awarded as well as ribbons/rosettes for all classes.
- All questions are welcome.

Stabling:

- Limited yards are available at the KRPC grounds. Please leave grounds as you found them and remove all manure from yards.
- Float parking is available on the oval until 11am, please have your float removed so that the fireworks can be set up.

Health & Safety:

- Helmets and boots must be worn by all riders, appropriate enclosed shoes are required for in-hand classes.
- Competitors are responsible for their own safety and that of their animals.
- Please ensure your horse is fit and well to compete.

Judging Criteria:

- Judges will be looking for conformation, temperament, performance, and presentation relevant to each class.
- All Judges choices are final, disrespect to the Judges or officials in anyway will not be tolerated.

Show Rules & Regulations

All competitors and spectators must adhere to the general rules of the Agricultural Show. Specific rules for the Horse Section are as follows:

- **Attire:** Appropriate riding attire must be worn in all ridden classes. Protective headwear is mandatory for all riders. Jackets and hacking gear is not mandatory, a clean shirt and saddle pad of your choosing is suffice.
- **Horse Welfare:** The welfare of the horse is paramount. Any instance of cruelty or neglect will result in disqualification and potential ban from future shows.
- **Grounds:** Please keep the showgrounds clean and tidy. All droppings must be cleared from arenas and walkways.
- **Complaints:** Any complaints must be lodged in writing with the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident.
